AN ACT TO ESTABLISH A COMPREHENSIVE TRAFFIC SAFETY EDUCATION PROGRAM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The fifth sentence of section 1A of Chapter 69 of the General
- 2 Laws is replaced by the following: —
- 3 Said director shall include within such curriculum the develop-
- 4 ment of a traffic safety education program for use in all public
- 5 elementary and high schools in the Commonwealth: said program
- 6 shall include pedestrian, bicycle and vehicle occupant safety com-
- 7 ponents; said director shall work in conjunction with the Massa-
- 8 chusetts Bicycle Advisory Board and the Bicycle Program
- 9 Manager to develop, implement, and review such a program.
