AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF HAVERHILL TO USE CERTAIN PARK LAND FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTING A NEW MUNICIPAL HOSPITAL.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The City of Haverhill is hereby authorized to
2 construct a new municipal hospital on a certain parcel of land
3 located in said city held for park purposes bounded and described
4 as follows:

5 Beginning at the Southeasterly side of Groveland Street in
6 Haverhill at its intersection with a service road leading to Kennedy
7 Circle, being shown as the Northwesterly corner of Lot #1, Block
8 153, Plan 423 in Assessors' Office; thence turning and running in a
9 Southwesterly direction along said Lot #1 and the service road for
10 a distance of approximately 120 feet; thence turning and running
11 along said service road in a Westerly direction for a distance of
12 approximately 740 feet to Brown Street; thence turning and
13 running in a Southeasterly direction along the Northerly side of
14 Brown Street for a distance of approximately 780 feet to Savage
15 Street; thence turning and running along the Westerly side of
16 Savage Street for a distance of approximately 500 feet, to a point
17 which marks the Southeasterly corner of Lot #7, Block 153, Plan
18 423 in Assessors' Office; thence turning and running along said
19 Lots #7, #6, #5 and #4 of Block 153, Plan 423 in a Northwesterly
20 direction for a distance of approximately 240 feet to the dividing

21 line of said Lots 3 and 4; thence turning and running in a
 22 Northeasterly direction along Lot #4, Block 153, Plan 423 to said
 23 Groveland Street; thence turning and running in a Northwesterly
 24 direction along said Groveland Street for a distance of ap-
 25 proximately 180 feet to the point of beginning.
 26 Consisting of approximately 9.06 acres.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
