AN ACT PROVIDING LIFE TENURE FOR MAURICE F. MC GRATH, JR., INCUMBENT OF THE OFFICE OF BUILDING INSPECTOR OF THE TOWN OF DRACUT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The tenure of office of Maurice F. McGrath, Jr.,
2 incumbent of the office of building inspector of the town of
3 Dracut shall, upon the effective date of this act, be unlimited,
4 but he may be removed therefrom for cause after hearing in the
5 manner provided by section forty-three of chapter thirty-one
6 of the General Laws.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its acceptance
2 by a majority vote of the town meeting members of said town
3 at an annual town meeting.
