AN ACT PROHIBITING THE DIRECTOR OF THE DIVISION OF
EMPLOYMENT SECURITY FROM REGULATING THE PAY-
MENTS OF COMPENSATION TO ATTORNEYS FOR EMPLOYEES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 Section 9J of chapter 23 of the General Laws, as
2 most recently amended by section 1 of chapter 20 of
3 the acts of 1939, is hereby further amended by insert-
4 ing after the first sentence the following new sentence:
5 — No such rule, regulation or order shall regulate in
6 any manner the payment of compensation to an at-
7 torney acting for or in behalf of an employee.
