

SENATE No. 286

To accompany the petition of Francis J. Horgan that the city of Boston be authorized to widen and extend Morton street in said city. Cities.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirteen.

AN ACT

Relative to the Widening and Extension of Morton Street in the City of Boston.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The city of Boston through its street
2 commissioners, with the approval of the mayor,
3 may widen, lay out, construct and extend Morton
4 street in the Dorchester district of the city of Bos-
5 ton from Norfolk street through Codman street,
6 Adams street and Minot street to Neponset avenue
7 in the Dorchester Lower Mills district of the city of
8 Boston, in accordance with the provisions of chap-
9 ter three hundred and ninety-three of the acts of the
10 year nineteen hundred and six, to a uniform width
11 of sixty feet.

1 SECTION 2. So much of said chapter three hun-
2 dred and ninety-three as limited assessments to land
3 within one hundred and twenty-five feet from said
4 improved Morton street shall not apply to any pro-
5 ceeding had, any pavements made or work done
6 under this act.

1 SECTION 3. For the purpose of this act, the treas-
2 urer of the city of Boston shall borrow, in the name
3 and on behalf of the city, such amounts as may be
4 required: *provided, however*, that the total amount
5 shall not exceed four hundred and fifty thousand
6 dollars.

1 SECTION 4. The amount authorized to be ex-
2 pended under this act may be borrowed outside of
3 the statutory limit of indebtedness of the city.

1 SECTION 5. This act shall take effect upon its
2 acceptance by the city council of Boston.
