### AN ACT REQUIRING WATER SKIERS TO WEAR PHOSPHORESCENT HEAD GEAR.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 91 of the General Laws is hereby amended by  
2 inserting after section 54 the following section: —

3 *Section 54A.* Every person who skis in water shall wear  
4 suitable head gear made with phosphorescent material so that  
5 he may easily be seen by others. Whoever violates the provi-  
6 sions of this section shall be punished by a fine of not more  
7 than twenty-five dollars.
