### AN ACT

To authorize the Towns of Orleans, Brewster and Harwich to unite for the Purpose of the Employment of a Superintendent of Schools.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 The towns of Orleans, Brewster and Harwich may
- 2 unite for the purpose of the employment of a superin-
- 3 tendent of schools, under the provisions of chapter four
- 4 hundred and thirty-one of the acts of the year eighteen
- 5 hundred and eighty-eight and amendments thereto.
