AN ACT ALLOWING CREDIT IN THE MASSACHUSETTS TEACHERS RETIREMENT SYSTEM FOR TEACHERS WHO HAVE SERVED IN OVERSEAS DEPENDENT SCHOOLS OPERATED BY THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1 of chapter 32 of the General Laws is hereby amended
2 by striking out the paragraph defining "Creditable Service" and
3 inserting in place thereof the following new paragraph:—
4 "Creditable Service," all membership service, prior service
5 and other service for which credit is allowable to any member
6 under the provisions of sections one to twenty-eight inclusive
7 and service in overseas dependent schools operated by the United
8 States Government.
