Bill accompanying statement of the Board of Education (House, No. 149). Education. January 2.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirteen.

AN ACT

Making Appropriations for the maintenance of Certain Independent Industrial Schools for the period previous to December First, Nineteen Hundred and Twelve.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned are
2 appropriated to be paid out of the treasury of the com-
3 monwealth from the ordinary revenue, for meeting the
4 commonwealth's proportion of the cost of maintenance
5 of independent industrial schools for the period previous
6 to December first, nineteen hundred and twelve, in cer-
7 tain cities and towns, under the authority of chapter four
8 hundred and seventy-one of the acts of nineteen hundred
9 and eleven, to wit:—

10 To the city of Beverly, the sum of two thousand six
11 hundred forty-two dollars and thirty-seven cents.

12 To the city of Boston, the sum of twenty-three
13 thousand two hundred two dollars and fifteen cents.

14 To the city of Cambridge, the sum of one thousand
15 seventy-five dollars and forty-four cents.

16 To the city of Chicopee, the sum of one thousand five
17 hundred nineteen dollars and eighty-six cents.

18 To the city of Everett, the sum of two thousand three
19 hundred twenty-one dollars and eighty cents.

20 To the city of Holyoke, the sum of nine hundred
21 ninety-seven dollars and eighty-seven cents.

22 To the city of Lawrence, for the period between July
23 one, nineteen hundred and eleven, and November five,
24 nineteen hundred and eleven, the sum of one thousand
25 nine hundred twenty-five dollars and fifty-seven cents.

26 To the city of Lawrence, for the period between
27 November six, nineteen hundred and eleven, and Novem-
28 ber thirty, nineteen hundred and twelve, the sum of
29 seven thousand four hundred ninety-four dollars and
30 eighty-seven cents.

31 To the city of Lowell, the sum of eleven thousand
32 two hundred seventy-five dollars and twenty-seven cents.

33 To the city of New Bedford, the sum of fourteen
34 thousand seven hundred eleven dollars and sixty-two
35 cents.

36 To the city of Newton, the sum of five thousand three
37 hundred fifty-nine dollars and sixty-nine cents.

38 To the town of North Attleboro, the sum of five
39 hundred fifty-three dollars and twenty-eight cents.

40 To the city of Quincy, the sum of two hundred ninety-
41 six dollars and eighty-three cents.

42 To the city of Somerville, the sum of seven thousand
43 four dollars and eighty-seven cents.

44 To the city of Springfield, the sum of six thousand
45 one hundred forty dollars and twelve cents.

46 To the city of Taunton, the sum of three hundred
47 thirty-nine dollars and seventy cents.

48 To the town of Watertown, the sum of ninety-eight
49 dollars and fifty-three cents.

50 To the town of Westfield, the sum of two thousand
51 three hundred eight dollars and sixty-five cents.

52 To the city of Worcester, the sum of seventeen
53 thousand six hundred sixty-four dollars and twenty-six
54 cents.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
