AN ACT RELATIVE TO PUBLISHED NOTICES OF PUBLIC HEARINGS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 2 to the contrary, any published notice of a public hearing held by

- 4 printed in bold, easily readable type.
