### AN ACT

#### Making Appropriations for the Massachusetts Highway Commission.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned  
2 are appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury  
3 of the Commonwealth, from the ordinary revenue,  
4 to meet the expenses of the Massachusetts high-  
5 way commission for the year ending on the thirty-  
6 first day of December nineteen hundred and one,  
7 to wit:—

8 For the salaries of the Massachusetts highway  
9 commission, the sum of eighty-five hundred dol-  
10 lars. [Acts 1898, chap. 528; 1900, chap. 474.]

(Appropriation 1900, \$6,000.)

11 For the salaries of the engineers, clerks and  
12 assistants in the office of the Massachusetts high-  
13 way commission, a sum not exceeding fifteen

14 thousand five hundred dollars. [Acts 1898, chap.  
15 528; 1900, chap. 474.]

(Appropriation 1900, \$17,060.)

16 For travelling and other expenses of the com-  
17 missioners, printing, postage and necessary office  
18 expenses, a sum not exceeding five thousand dol-  
19 lars. [Acts 1898, chap. 528.]

(Appropriation 1900, \$5,440.)

20 For rent of offices for the use of the Massachu-  
21 setts highway commission, a sum not exceeding  
22 four thousand seven hundred and fifty dollars.  
23 [Acts 1900, chap. 474.]

(No Appropriation 1900.)

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon his  
2 passage.
