AN ACT TO FURTHER REGULATE A LEARNER'S PERMIT FOR MOTORCYCLE OPERATORS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 8B of chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by striking out "from provided, however, that if the
3 applicant has been issued a learner's permit restricted to the
4 operation of a motorcycle" and inserting the following:—"all
5 applicants for a motorcycle learner's permit must first have been
6 issued either a Class 1, 2 or 3 Massachusetts Motor Vehicle
7 operators license."
