AN ACT CHANGING THE NAME OF THE APPEALS COURT TO THE COURT OF APPEALS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 211A of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by striking out the caption, as inserted by section 1
3 of chapter 740 of the acts of 1972, and inserting in place
4 thereof the following caption: —

5 COURT OF APPEALS.

1 SECTION 2. The General Laws are hereby amended by
2 striking out the words "appeals court," wherever it appears,
3 and inserting in place thereof the words: — court of appeals.
