AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF ATTLEBORO TO GRANT AN ADDITIONAL LICENSE FOR THE SALE OF ALL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES NOT TO BE DRUNK ON THE PREMISES TO K. & S., INC., D/B/A BRIGGS CORNER PACKAGE STORE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of section seventeen of chapter  
2 one hundred and thirty-eight of the General Laws, the licensing  
3 authority of the city of Attleboro is hereby authorized to grant to  
4 K. & S., Inc., d/b/a Briggs Corner Package Store, a license for all  
5 alcoholic beverages not to be drunk on the premises under the  
6 provisions of section fifteen of said chapter one hundred and  
7 thirty-eight. Said license shall be subject to all the provisions of  
8 said chapter one hundred and thirty-eight except section seven-  
9 teen. Provided that said licensing authority shall not approve the  
10 transfer of said license within one year after the date of issuance,  
11 and provided further if the holder of said license is a corporation,  
12 said licensing authority shall not approve the transfer, pledging or  
13 issuance of shares of stock of such corporation within one year  
14 after the date of issuance, and provided further that the number of  
15 licenses for the sale of wine and malt beverages not to be drunk on  
16 the premises authorized for said city to grant under the provisions  
17 of said section seventeen of said chapter one hundred and thirty-  
18 eight shall be reduced by one such license.
