AN ACT TO ALLEVIATE HARDSHIP IMPOSED BY LOSS OF DRIVERS'
LICENSES IN CERTAIN CASES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 adding at the end of paragraph (1) (c) of section 24 thereof
3 the following: Notwithstanding the foregoing, the registrar
4 may, at any time, grant a conditional license to any person
5 having lost his license under this paragraph, upon a showing
6 by such person that driving is necessary to such person's
7 trade, business or employment. Such a conditional license
8 shall be valid only when the holder is driving to, from or in
9 the course of his trade, business or occupation, and may be
10 upon such further conditions, including but not limited to par-
11 ticipation in counselling or educational programs, as the
12 registrar may prescribe.
