AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A COVERED OUTDOOR
SKATING RINK IN THE CITY OF LYNN.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

- 1 The metropolitan district commission is hereby authorized
- 2 and directed to construct and maintain a covered outdoor skat-
- 3 ing rink in the city of Lynn. For the purposes of this act, said
- 4 commission may expend such sums as may be appropriated
- 5 therefor.

The Commission on Government

Report of the Commission on Government

The Commission on Government was organized in 1955 to study the structure and functions of the Federal Government. It has since that time held numerous public hearings and has received many suggestions from citizens and officials. The Commission's report is the result of its study and is intended to provide a basis for the reform of the Federal Government.

The Commission believes that the Federal Government should be reorganized so that it can function more effectively and efficiently. It recommends that the Executive, Legislative, and Judicial Branches be restructured to eliminate overlapping functions and to provide for a more balanced and effective government.

The Commission also recommends that the Federal Government be reorganized so that it can better serve the needs of the people. It suggests that the Federal Government should be more responsive to the needs of the States and the people, and that it should be more accountable to the people.
