AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF FAIRHAVEN TO ISSUE AN ADDITIONAL LICENSE FOR THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES TO FORT PHOENIX POST 2892, VETERANS OF FOREIGN WARS OF U.S.A., INC.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section seven-
2 teen of chapter one hundred and thirty-eight of the General Laws
3 the licensing authority of the Town of Fairhaven is hereby autho-
4 rized to issue to Fort Phoenix Post 2892, Veterans of Foreign Wars
5 of U.S.A., Inc. a license to sell all alcoholic beverages to be drunk
6 on the premises at 109 Middle Street, Fairhaven under the provi-
7 sions of section twelve of said chapter one hundred and thirty-
8 eight. Said license shall be subject to all of the provisions of said
9 chapter one hundred and thirty-eight except said section seventeen
10 and except that the license authorized by this act may not be trans-
11 ferred to another location, but may be transferred to another
12 person at the same location.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
