### AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE FILLING OF VACANCIES IN THE SCHOOL COMMITTEE OF THE CITY OF GLOUCESTER.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. A vacancy in the school committee of the city of  
2 Gloucester shall be filled in accordance with chapter two hun-  
3 dred and thirty of the acts of nineteen hundred and fifty-four  
4 relating to filling vacancies in elective bodies in certain cities  
5 having a Plan E charter, provided, however, that in the event  
6 there is no defeated candidate who is eligible and willing to serve,  
7 said vacancy shall be filled by the mayor and remaining members  
8 of the school committee, within fifteen days after the said va-  
9 cancy arises, by electing a suitable person to fill the vacancy for  
10 the unexpired term.

1 SECTION 2. Section three of chapter ninety-seven of the acts  
2 of nineteen hundred and fifty-five is hereby repealed.
