In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-Three.

AN ACT ESTABLISHING THE SALARY OF THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF LEOMINSTER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section twelve of chapter three hun-
2 dred and thirty-eight of the Special Acts of nineteen
3 hundred and fifteen is hereby amended by striking
4 out, in the second and third lines, the words "not ex-
5 ceeding one thousand dollars a year," and inserting
6 in place thereof the words: — not less than two thou-
7 sand nor exceeding five thousand dollars a year, —
8 so as to read as follows: — *Section 12.* The mayor
9 shall receive for his services such salary as the city
10 council shall by ordinance determine, not less than
11 two thousand nor exceeding five thousand dollars a
12 year, and he shall receive no other compensation from
13 the city. His salary shall not be increased or dimin-
14 ished during the term for which he is elected. The
15 council may by a two thirds vote of all its members,

16 taken by call of the yeas and nays, establish a salary
17 for its members, not exceeding five hundred dollars
18 each a year. Such salary may be reduced, but no
19 increase therein shall be made to take effect during
20 the year in which the increase is voted.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take full effect on its
2 acceptance, during the current year, by vote of the
3 city council of the city of Leominster, but not other-
4 wise.
