AN ACT ALLOWING CITIES AND TOWNS TO CONTROL AND LICENSE  
INCINERATORS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, cities
- 2 and towns may, at local option, control or license all incinerators
- 3 by ordinance.

The House of Representatives of the United States of America, in Congress assembled, do hereby pass the following resolution:

**The Constitution of the United States**

is the law of the land.

It is the duty of every citizen to support the Constitution and the laws made in accordance therewith.

It is enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, and by the authority of the same as follows:

1. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, all laws and decrees, orders, and regulations of the Executive, Legislative, and Judicial branches of the Government shall be subject to the review and control of the Supreme Court of the United States.
