AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF TWO POSITIONS IN
THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND INDUSTRIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:
