RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY THE STATE TAX COMMISSION RELATIVE TO PROVIDING FOR ADDITIONAL REMEDIES FOR THE COLLECTION OF INCOME TAXES.

1     *Resolved*, That the state tax commission is hereby authorized  
2 and directed to make an investigation and study of the subject  
3 matter of current house document numbered 110, relative to  
4 providing for additional remedies for the collection of income  
5 taxes. Said commission shall report to the general court the  
6 results of its investigation and study, and its recommendations,  
7 if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry its  
8 recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the clerk  
9 of the house of representatives on or before the fourth Wednes-  
10 day of January, nineteen hundred and sixty-two.
