## Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred.

### AN ACT

Making an Appropriation for Continuing the Work  
of Exterminating the Gypsy Moth.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. A sum not exceeding sixteen  
2 thousand dollars is hereby appropriated, to be  
3 paid out of the treasury of the Commonwealth,  
4 from the ordinary revenue, to be expended under  
5 the direction of the state board of agriculture, as  
6 authorized by chapter two hundred and ten of the  
7 acts of the year eighteen hundred and ninety-one,  
8 for meeting expenses in connection with the ex-  
9 termination of the gypsy moth between the first  
10 day of January and the first day of May of the  
11 present year.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
