AN ACT

Extending the time for the location and construction of the Mystic River Railroad.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 The time allowed to locate the Mystic River Rail-
2 road, is hereby extended to the first day of May,
3 eighteen hundred and sixty-eight, and to construct the
4 same to the first day of May, eighteen hundred and
5 sixty-nine.
