AN ACT PROHIBITING THE USE BY THE PUBLIC OF DINING FACILITIES  
OF CERTAIN CORPORATIONS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 6 of Chapter 180 of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by adding the following paragraph at the end of  
3 said section:

4 Notwithstanding the provisions of any special or general  
5 laws to the contrary, no corporation organized under this  
6 chapter shall solicit or advertise for the use of its dining facil-  
7 ities by members of the general public.

8 A violation of this foregoing provision shall result in the  
9 suspension or revocation of the certificate of incorporation of  
10 said corporation.
