AN ACT REGULATING THE FARE ON THE M.B.T.A. RELATIVE TO SENIOR CITIZENS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 That any person sixty-five years of age and over be entitled
- 2 to ride on the M.B.T.A. lines for a fare of fifteen cents, each
- 3 way, upon the showing of a special senior citizens pass, which
- 4 would be issued by the M.B.T.A., upon application having
- 5 been made by said senior citizen, upon an official form to be
- 6 provided by the M.B.T.A.
- 7 Be it further provided that said senior citizen would be
- 8 provided with such transfers as necessary in order that said
- 9 senior citizen would pay no more than fifteen cents as pre-
- 10 scribed for by this bill.
