RESOLVE INCREASING THE SCOPE OF THE SPECIAL COMMISSION ESTABLISHED TO MAKE AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY RELATIVE TO SETTING UP A PUBLIC EMPLOYMENT PROGRAM FOR UNEMPLOYED PERSONS.
