### RESOLVE

To extend the Time for the Report of the Committee appointed to consider the Advisability of constructing a Dam across the Charles River between the Cities of Boston and Cambridge.

1 *Resolved*, That the time within which the committee,  
2 appointed under chapter one hundred and five of the  
3 resolves of the year nineteen hundred and one, to con-  
4 sider the advisability of constructing a dam across the  
5 Charles river between the cities of Boston and Cam-  
6 bridge, is required to report to the general court be ex-  
7 tended until the second Wednesday in January in the  
8 year nineteen hundred and three.
