AN ACT TO CLARIFY THE EMPLOYMENT AGENCY LAW.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 46A of Chapter 140 of the General
2 Laws is hereby amended by striking the entire proviso clause
3 commencing with the words "provided" to the end of the para-
4 graph in the definition of "Employment agency" in said Sec-
5 tion 46A.

1 SECTION 2. The next to last paragraph in Section 46L of
2 Chapter 140 of the General Laws is deleted.

1 SECTION 3. The following new paragraph is added to Sec-
2 tion 46R of Chapter 140 of the General Laws:

3 Any officers of corporations and any managers of employ-
4 ment agencies shall also be individually liable for any viola-
5 tions of section forty-six B, forty-six C, forty-six E, F, J, K,
6 L, M, N and O of Chapter 140 and shall be individually sub-
7 ject to the penalties provided in this section.
