## Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Nine.

### AN ACT

To incorporate The Winchester Hospital.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Lewis Parkhurst, George Harring-  
2 ton, Preston Pond, William D. Richards, Alfred S.  
3 Higgins, Nelson H. Seelye, John L. Ayer and Wil-  
4 liam B. French, their associates and successors, are  
5 hereby made a corporation by the name of The  
6 Winchester Hospital, for the purpose of establish-  
7 ing and maintaining a hospital in the town of Win-  
8 chester for the care and treatment of sick and  
9 disabled persons, with all the powers and privileges,  
10 and subject to all the duties and restrictions and  
11 liabilities set forth in the General Laws which now

12 are or may hereafter be in force, relating to such  
13 corporations; and for the purpose aforesaid said  
14 corporation may hold real and personal property  
15 not exceeding two hundred and fifty thousand dol-  
16 lars in value.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.

AN ACT

To incorporate the Winchester Hospital.  
Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Assembly, that the following be the charter of the  
said hospital, to-wit:  
SECTION 1. That Frederick, George, Garrison,  
J. son, Preston Ford, William H. Hilditch, Alfred E.  
J. Hilditch, Nelson H. Hilditch, John E. Hilditch and Will-  
iam H. Hilditch, their heirs and assigns, do hereby  
solely make a corporation of the name of the  
Winchester Hospital, for the purpose of establish-  
ing and maintaining a hospital in the town of Win-  
chester for the care and treatment of sick and  
diseased persons, with all the powers and privileges  
and subject to all the duties and restrictions and  
regulations which may be from time to time
