The committee on Bills in the Third Reading to which was referred the Senate Bill imposing penalties for making false statements in certain applications required to be filed by law (Senate, No. 507, changed and amended) reports recommending that the same be amended by substituting therefor a new draft entitled "An Act providing that boards of registrations shall revoke the certificates of registration of persons making false statements under oath in their applications" (Senate, No. 734) and that, when so amended the same will be correctly drawn.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT BOARDS OF REGISTRATION SHALL REVOKE THE CERTIFICATES OF REGISTRATION OF PERSONS MAKING FALSE STATEMENTS UNDER OATH IN THEIR APPLICATIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 112 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by striking out the caption, preceding section 61 as
3 appearing in the Tercentenary Edition, and inserting in place
4 thereof the following caption: — GENERAL PROVISIONS
5 RELATIVE TO EACH BOARD OF REGISTRATION OR
6 EXAMINATION IN THE DIVISION OF REGISTRATION
7 OF THE DEPARTMENT OF CIVIL SERVICE AND REG-
8 ISTRATION.

1 SECTION 2. Said section 61, as so appearing, is hereby
2 amended by inserting after the word "registration", the first
3 time it appears in line 2, the words: — or examination.

1 SECTION 3. Said section 61, as so appearing, is hereby
2 further amended by adding at the end the following para-
3 graph: — Each such board, if it appears after a hearing that
4 a statement in an application to it for certification, registra-
5 tion, licensure or authority, which is required to be under
6 oath or affirmation or to contain or be verified by a written
7 declaration that it is made under penalties of perjury, is false
8 and known to the applicant to be false, shall refuse to grant
9 or issue or shall revoke or cancel such certificate, registration,
10 license or authority. The provisions of this paragraph shall
11 not affect, but shall be in addition to, any other penalty pro-
12 vided by law.
