AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE POSITION OF CITY FORESTER IN THE CITY OF MARLBOROUGH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any provision of law to
2 the contrary, the position of city forester for the city
3 of Marlborough shall be placed under the provisions of
4 the civil service laws and rules with the title of "Super-
5 visor of Forestry."

1 SECTION 2. The position shall be filled by a competi-
2 tive promotional examination open to all permanent
3 employees in the forestry department who have been
4 employed therein after certification for at least one year.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its ac-
2 ceptance by the mayor and city council of the city of
3 Marlborough in the current year.
