AN ACT

Concerning the Cape Cod Railroad Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 SECT. 1. The Cape Cod Railroad Company is
2 hereby authorized to cross any highways and town-
3 ways between its present terminus in Orleans and
4 its contemplated terminus in Provincetown, at grade,
5 in such manner as the county commissioners of the
6 county of Barnstable shall prescribe.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its pas-
2 sage.
