## Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Seventy-Eight.

### AN ACT

To authorize the Town of West Springfield to borrow  
Money for Certain Purposes.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :*

1    SECT. 1. The town of West Springfield is hereby  
2 authorized to issue bonds, not exceeding in amount  
3 the sum of twenty-five thousand dollars, payable in  
4 twenty years from the date thereof, and bearing  
5 interest at a rate not exceeding six per centum per  
6 annum, for the payment of the amount imposed  
7 upon said town under chapter one hundred and  
8 thirty of the acts of the year eighteen hundred and  
9 seventy-two, entitled "An Act to establish a free  
10 bridge across the Connecticut River between Spring-  
11 field and West Springfield."

1    SECT. 2. The provisions of chapter two hundred  
2 and nine of the acts of the year eighteen hundred

3 and seventy-five, in regard to a sinking-fund for the  
4 payment of debts contracted in constructing general  
5 sewers, and the acts amendatory thereof, shall apply  
6 to this act; and said town of West Springfield is  
7 hereby required to create a sinking-fund in accord-  
8 ance therewith, for the payment of said bonds at  
9 their maturity.

1    SECT. 3.   This act shall take effect upon its pas-  
2 sage.
