The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Two.

AN ACT TO FURTHER DEFINE THE UNAUTHORIZED PRACTICE OF LAW.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 41, of chapter 22I, of the General Laws, is hereby
2 amended by inserting in line 17 of said section after the word
3 'person' the following words: — “. . . or holds himself out as a
4 labor relations, or wage survey consultant or labor negotiator
5 whose services include the negotiating, drafting and legal review
6 of collective bargaining agreements and the rendering of legal
7 advice growing out of said agreements to any governmental
8 unit of the commonwealth”
