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## Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety-nine.

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### AN ACT

Relative to the making of Returns of Steam Boilers.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Section ninety-two of chapter
- 2 eleven of the Public Statutes is hereby amended
- 3 by striking out said section and inserting in place
- 4 thereof the following new section:—
- 5 “Section 92. All persons owning or operating a
- 6 steam boiler under lease or otherwise shall on or
- 7 before the first Monday in August in each year
- 8 file with the chief of the district police a statement
- 9 giving the number of boilers under their control,
- 10 the number of horse-power of each, the street and
- 11 number or other definite location if not numbered,

12 and if insured, the name of the insurance company  
13 insuring the same: *provided, however*, that such  
14 report shall not include boilers located in private  
15 residences.

1 SECTION 2. Every boiler insurance company  
2 authorized to do business in this Commonwealth  
3 shall, on the first day of August of each year, file  
4 with the chief of the district police a statement  
5 showing the whole number of boilers in this Com-  
6 monwealth insured by them, the city or town in  
7 which each boiler is located, together with the  
8 name of street and number of street, or other  
9 definite location of such boiler, and the name of  
10 the owner or user of each boiler, and shall  
11 monthly thereafter file with the chief of the dis-  
12 trict police a similar statement, giving therein the  
13 name of the owner or user and definite location  
14 of each boiler insured by them during the month  
15 next preceding, together with a similar statement  
16 giving the name of the owner or user and definite  
17 location of each boiler upon which the policy of  
18 insurance has been cancelled or lapsed during the  
19 preceding month.

1 SECTION 3. Any person, firm, company or cor-  
2 poration failing to comply with the provisions of  
3 this act shall be subject to a fine of not less than  
4 fifty dollars for each offence.

1 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
