AN ACT RELATIVE TO ALLIED HEALTH INSTRUCTORS AT VOCATIONAL SCHOOLS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 74 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 5B the following  
2 section:— Section 5C. Registered nurses who serve as allied health instructors at a vocational school and  
3 possess bachelor or master degrees in nursing shall not be required to take an additional exams or courses  
4 to qualify as such.
