AN ACT LIMITING THE VENUE OF TRANSITORY ACTIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 223, Section 2 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by striking the period at the end of the first para-
3 graph thereof and adding the following words: "and excepting
4 further that all actions in contract shall be brought in the
5 county where one of the defendants lives or has his usual place
6 of business and in any judicial district of said county."

The act shall be construed to be in conformity with the intent of the Legislature to limit the power of temporary appointments.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE VENUE OF LEGISLATIVE ACTIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the said Senate and House, that the following shall be the law:

1. Chapter 222, Section 2 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking the words "at the end of the first paragraph thereof and adding the following words: "and wherever a further fact or matter in controversy shall be brought in the course of any of the proceedings here or hereinafter provided for in any judicial district or said courts."
