

- Chap. 32.** AN ACT DESIGNATING THE BRIDGE OVER ROUTE 140 ON ROUTE 24 IN THE CITY OF TAUNTON AS THE LIEUTENANT WILLIAM C. MURPHY BRIDGE.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The bridge over state highway route 140 on state highway route 24 in the city of Taunton shall be known and designated as the Lieutenant William C. Murphy bridge, in memory of Lieutenant William C. Murphy, who was killed in action in Vietnam while a member of the armed forces of the United States. A suitable marker bearing said designation shall be attached thereto by the department of public works.

- Chap. 33.** AN ACT PROVIDING TENURE RIGHTS FOR SCHOOL ADJUSTMENT COUNSELLORS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Chapter 71 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 38I the following section:—

Section 38J. Every school adjustment counsellor appointed by a school committee and receiving approval under the provisions of section forty-six G shall acquire tenure in the school system of the city or town in which he is employed, subject to the provisions of section forty-one, relating to tenure for teachers, and of sections forty-two and forty-three A, relating to dismissal, suspension and discharge, and of appeals therefrom.

- Chap. 34.** AN ACT DESIGNATING THE BRIDGE OVER ROUTE 79 ON RELOCATED ROUTE 140 IN THE CITY OF TAUNTON AS THE DOUGLAS J. LEMAIRE BRIDGE.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The bridge over state highway Route 79 on relocated highway Route 140 in the city of Taunton shall be known and designated as the Douglas J. Lemaire bridge, in memory of Warrant Officer Douglas J. Lemaire who was a member of the armed forces of the United States in the Vietnam War. A suitable marker bearing said designation shall be attached thereto by the department of public works.

- Chap. 35.** AN ACT DESIGNATING A CERTAIN HIGHWAY TO BE CONSTRUCTED IN WORCESTER COUNTY AS THE VIETNAM VETERANS HIGHWAY.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

That portion of the highway to be constructed from a point on state highway route 140 in the town of West Boylston to a point on state highway route 2 in northern Worcester county shall be designated and known as the Vietnam Veterans highway, in honor of the veterans of the Vietnam campaign.

The department of public works shall erect and maintain along said highway suitable markers bearing said designation.
