## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE SALARY OF THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY FOR THE SUFFOLK COUNTY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 12 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking  
2 out section 15, as most recently amended by section 1 of chapter  
3 632 of the Acts of 1976, and inserting in place thereof the following  
4 new section:—

5 *Section 15.* District Attorneys shall devote their entire time  
6 during ordinary business hours to their duties, shall neither directly  
7 nor indirectly engage in the practice of law, and shall receive from  
8 the Commonwealth a salary of thirty-six thousand two hundred  
9 and three dollars, annually, except that the salary of the District  
10 Attorney for the Suffolk District shall be forty-five thousand  
11 dollars annually.
