AN ACT PROVIDING HIGHER EDUCATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES FOR THE CHILDREN OF MASSACHUSETTS MEN AND WOMEN WHO DIED AS A RESULT OF CAUSES RESULTING FROM SERVICE IN THE ARMY OR NAVY OF THE UNITED STATES DURING THE WORLD WAR.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The provisions of chapter two hundred and sixty-
2 three of the acts of nineteen hundred and thirty shall
3 apply to children of men and women who died from
4 causes connected with the service of said parents in
5 the military or naval service of the United States be-
6 tween April sixth, nineteen hundred and seventeen
7 and July second, nineteen hundred and twenty-one.
