RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION BY THE JUDICIAL COUNCIL RELATIVE TO PROVIDING THAT CERTAIN RECORDS SHALL NOT BE PRESENTED TO THE COURT BY PROBATION OFFICERS PRIOR TO DISPOSITION.

1 *Resolved*, That the judicial council be requested to investi-  
2 gate the subject matter of current senate document numbered  
3 220, relative to providing that certain records shall not be pre-  
4 sented to the court by probation officers prior to disposition,  
5 and to include its conclusions and its recommendations, if any,  
6 in relation thereto, together with drafts of such legislation as  
7 may be necessary to give effect to the same, in its annual re-  
8 port for the current year.
