Resolutions memorializing Congress in Favor of Additional Appropriations of Money for Use by the Home Owners' Loan Corporation in Continuing its Activities.

- 1 *Resolved*, That the general court hereby records
- 2 itself in favor of the appropriation by the Congress
- 3 of the United States of additional funds for use
- 4 by the Home Owners' Loan Corporation so that
- 5 said corporation may continue its activities for the
- 6 benefit of distressed home owners and particularly
- 7 those whose applications for loans from said cor-
- 8 poration were filed and pending when said corpora-
- 9 tion ceased making loans; and be it further
- 10 *Resolved*, That the secretary of the common-
- 11 wealth forthwith forward copies of these resolutions
- 12 to the president of the United States, to the presiding
- 13 officers of both branches of congress and to the
- 14 members thereof from this commonwealth.
