## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Two.

AN ACT TO PROVIDE STATE RETIREES WITH A COST-OF-LIVING ADJUSTMENT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding so much of the provisions of section one  
2 hundred and two of chapter thirty-two of the General Laws as  
3 pertains to the comparison determined by the life actuary in the  
4 division of insurance, but in all other respects subject to the  
5 provisions of said section one hundred and two of said chapter  
6 thirty-two, the retirement allowance, pension or annuity of every  
7 former employee of the Commonwealth or of any county, city,  
8 town, district, housing or redevelopment authority, of the  
9 Massachusetts Port Authority, the Blue Hills Regional  
10 Vocational School system, the Greater Lawrence Sanitary  
11 District, the Minuteman Regional Vocational Technical School  
12 District or of the spouse or other beneficiary of any such former  
13 employee who is receiving a retirement allowance, pension or  
14 annuity pursuant to said chapter shall, beginning July first of  
15 nineteen hundred and ninety-two, be increased by five percent.
