The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand and Nine

AN ACT RELATIVE TO DESIGNATING A CERTAIN AREA IN THE CITY OF WORCESTER AS A PLACE OF PEACE HEALING GARDEN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The Route 20 section off of Millbury Street in the City of Worcester shall be designated and
- 2 known as a Place of Peace Healing Garden, in memory of those who have lost their lives to cancer and
- 3 those currently living with Cancer. The department of conservation and recreation shall, subject to
- 4 appropriation, erect and maintain suitable markers bearing the designation in compliance with the
- 5 standards of the department.
