### AN ACT EXTENDING THE HOURS FOR SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES TO CERTAIN LICENSEES WITHIN THE CITY OF BOSTON.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The sixth paragraph of section 12 of chapter 138 of the General  
2 Laws, as amended by chapter 336 of the acts of 1955, is hereby  
3 further amended by inserting after the word "meridian", in  
4 line 6, the words: — , except that in the city of Boston these  
5 hours shall be on any day between the hours of two and eight  
6 o'clock antemeridian,.
