AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NORFOLK COUNTY TO GRANT TO CERTAIN CITY AND TOWNS A CREDIT AGAINST THEIR COUNTY TAX ASSESSMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 582 of the Acts and Resolves of 1975 is hereby
2 amended by substituting for Section "3" thereof the following
3 section:

4 *Section 3.* The County Commissioners of Norfolk County
5 are hereby authorized and directed to deduct from the assessment
6 to be paid by the City of Quincy and the Towns of Brookline,
7 Milton, Wellesley and Weymouth based upon the first County
8 tax to be apportioned and assessed following the enactment into
9 law of this Act, the following respective amounts:

10	City of Quincy	\$91,936.68
11	Town of Brookline	24.24
12	Town of Milton	31,862.93
13	Town of Wellesley	71,581.74
14	Town of Weymouth	126,240.83

15 The within stated credit for the City of Quincy in the amount
16 of \$91,936.68 recognizes a previous credit made pursuant to
17 Chapter 582 of the Acts and Resolves of 1975, to the City of
18 Quincy in the amount of \$604,000.00, the total having been due to
19 the City of Quincy having been \$695,936.68.
