AN ACT RELATIVE TO HOLIDAY PROVISIONS FOR STATE EMPLOYEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 24A of chapter 30 of the General Laws as most
2 recently amended by chapter 423 of the acts of 1964 is hereby
3 amended by striking out, after the first comma, in the first
4 sentence the words "as listed in the first sentence of clause
5 Eighteenth of section seven of chapter four" and inserting in
6 place thereof the following words: — as listed in the first two
7 sentences of clause Eighteenth of section seven of chapter four.
