AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE TOTAL CONSTRUCTION GRANT FOR CERTAIN APPROVED SCHOOL PROJECTS IN CITIES, TOWNS AND REGIONAL SCHOOL DISTRICTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 9 of chapter 645 of the acts of 1948, as most
2 recently amended by section 2 of chapter 528 of the acts
3 of 1950, is hereby further amended by adding at the end
4 the following paragraph: —

5 Anything in this act to the contrary notwithstanding,
6 the total construction grant for every school project
7 becoming an approved school project within the meaning
8 of this act after July first, nineteen hundred and fifty-six,
9 whether in a city, town or regional school district, shall
10 be one half of the final approved cost of the project.
