AN ACT TO FURTHER REGULATE THE PENALTY FOR FISHING,
HUNTING AND TRAPPING ON POSTED LAND.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 100 of chapter 131 of the General Laws is
2 hereby amended by adding at the end, the following
3 sentence:— Any city or town that votes to prohibit
4 fishing, hunting and trapping within its municipal bound-
5 aries shall cause said municipal boundaries to be con-
6 spicuously posted as provided for in the posting of pri-
7 vate property as stated in the foregoing paragraph. Any
8 city or town which fails to post its municipal boundaries
9 conspicuously shall be considered unposted lands, and
10 fishing, hunting and trapping shall not be considered
11 prohibitive., — so as to read as follows:— *Section 100.*
12 Whoever fishes, hunts or traps on private land without
13 permission of the owner or tenant thereof, after such
14 owner or tenant has conspicuously posted thereon no-
15 tices, bearing thereon the name of such owner or tenant,
16 stating thereon that fishing, hunting or trapping thereon,
17 as the case may be, is prohibited, shall be punished by
18 a fine of not more than twenty dollars. Any city or
19 town that votes to prohibit fishing, hunting and trapping
20 within its municipal boundaries shall cause said municipi-
21 pal boundaries to be conspicuously posted as provided

22 for in the posting of private property as stated in the
 23 foregoing paragraph. Any city or town that fails to
 24 conspicuously post its municipal boundaries shall not be
 25 considered posted lands, and fishing, hunting and trap-
 26 ping shall not be considered prohibitive.
